

Dear Beloveds,

This past year has been another very busy year for SSC with many new initiatives and improvements. We started 2022 with a much needed new website suficommunities.org. The new site is beautiful, alive, packed with resources for all levels, and now has a whole section dedicated to beginners and those who are interested in Sufism that explains the basics of the path.

We also have new donation processing software which makes it easer for both the donor and for us. There have been overall improvements with streamlining our bookkeeping, which keeps our accounts clear, balanced, and up to date.

Along with these updates we also created an extensive AML (anti-money laundering) policy which brings us into compliance with all national and international banking requirements. The AML policy forms the cornerstone of our donation collection and distribution policies, which are transparent and contain checks and balances to ensure we remain clean and straight.

We worked with Regional Council Members to update the SSC Bylaws, making it easier for new members to join the board, along with other minor clarifications.

We also initiated the new Waliyy Support Circle, a group of board members and volunteers which focuses on the changing needs of community and creates responses to those needs. This group has been working on establishing the Fatiha Hotline where beloveds experiencing a moment of crisis can call and be heard and receive a prayer from a beloved brother or sister. They are also working on a weekly support group to serve beloveds with ongoing needs.

SSC collaborated with the University of Sufism to create new promise packets that include the Getting Started book, beads, and other resources. These packets are available to every new beloved at no cost.



We have begun migrating all of the Worship Meetings from the old conference call line to a Zoom platform, which allows free access to international and some U.S. students who are charged a per-minute fee on the conference line.

We began collaborating with the Sidi Archival Project and a link to the Sidi Audio Library on Soundcloud.com is posted prominently on our website. This library is a collection of Sidi's teachings in mp3 form that is available to everyone at no charge.

In October 2022, our board of directors participated in our first Board Retreat in Santa Fe, NM. We were able to get a lot of important work done that could not have happened during our regular board meetings. We connected more deeply and were able to unify our hearts for the work and challenges ahead.

For 2023 SSC's intention is to continue to expand our operations to support more beloveds and communities, including our growing International community. This will include incorporating a growth engine component that will be fed by increased programming, which we hope will nourish beloveds and help generate income. This is one part of our long range strategic plan to increase our service to community.

We are also looking at ways to expand our outreach to bring in new seekers who can taste the benefits of being a part of our community. If God wills, this will also help bring new beloveds into the fold of the other organizations and overall contribute to the growth of our community.

We also plan to keep working with teachers who have himma to serve to help them teach what is in their hearts to offer, including a few 3 or 4 day workshops. We have also budgeted to better compensate the teachers who do teach for SSC so as to make it easer for them to prepare and offer well-crafted content for beloveds.

We are also planning for more upgrades to our website, doing more direct work with community through the Waliyy Support Circle, and continuing to do our part to work towards more unity and harmony across our community.

We are excited about these new doors of service Allah Most High is opening up for us and are looking forward to a time of hope and prosperity for our entire community, inshallah.

2022 Offerings

Beloveds In Need Program

Our Beloveds In Need program offers financial assistance to community members in crisis. In 2022 we were able to give \$173,504.17 to community members in the U.S. who were in financial crisis. This includes money collected and distributed through our Beloveds In Need program, annual charity collected for and distributed to community members, annual charity that helps people purchase food and clothing for 'Eid al-Fitr, and a grant we received and distributed to victims of the Napa County wildfires that occurred in 2020. We are so grateful to Allah for all that He gives us.

Sidi's Charities

SSC was blessed in our third year of receiving your donations to support Sidi's charities. We were able to send \$278,811.19 to support beloveds in need around the world.

By-Donation Online Programs

In 2022 we offered over 130 online classes accessible through Zoom, alhamdulillah! Many of these classes center around the holy month of Ramadan, may Allah help us all to reach it, and other holy days. The everpopular Mercy Circle, an ongoing group that runs twice a month, continues to thrive with new guest speakers each month. In 2022 we were able to add several new ongoing classes to enrich and support your spiritual growth and transformation, including How to Have Difficult Conversations. Our programs are by-donation, which means you offer the donation you can afford in gratitude for what you receive, insha'allah.



2022 Financial Overview

On December 31, 2021, we had \$1,527,707.08 invested in Azzad Asset Management, \$267,306.39 in our primary checking account, \$54,946.80 in our supplemental checking account, and \$92,525.58 in PayPal.

Investing in the Future

SSC received an additional \$158,250.00 in compensation for the fire damage, bringing the total insurance compensation we received to \$2,924,136.82. There are a number of one-time expenses that have enabled SSC to be debt-free and in a position where we can operate effectively and continue fulfilling our mission, God willing.
